VOTING | Vote in as many or as few categories as you wish — but you may make only one selection per category.

NEW TALENT AWARD | Book title(s) listed in this category are not meant to be inclusive, but to note which title most often appeared beside each nominee in the nominating ballots recieved.

2003 REFERENDUM

No substantial changes are made in the ground rules affecting the HARVEYS without input from the professional community. This year we are requesting you answer the following question: Should a potential nominee be allowed to withdraw his/her name from appearing as a nominee on a HARVEY ballot?

PRO: | Should a creator believe it best that their name not be on the ballot, that decision should be recognized. Additionally, in cases where an individual may have more than one nomination in a given category, it is unfair to be forced to compete against oneself.

CON: | While winners may elect not to accept an award, the HARVEY AWARDS exists so that the professional community may recognize quality work. It is unfair for an individual to thwart that recognition. As the publication of many works often requires the input of several individuals, the withdrawal of a potential nomination also impacts the entire creative team as well as the publisher.
